What is Suffolk Foot and Ankle doing to protect patients and staff?

Suffolk Foot and Ankle is committed to the health and safety of our patients and staff. In addition to our regular cleaning practices, we have increased cleaning practices within all of our offices.

- All waiting rooms and bathrooms are being cleaned and sanitized during all breaks/lunches, and at night after office hours.
- All exam rooms are being sanitized in between each patient appointment, and additionally at night after office hours.
